Details are as follows:

- You must be an IPRA member to qualify for any awards.
- You must compete in a minimum of 7 Born to Buck Tour rodeos to qualify for Tour end awards
 - Standings will be posted after each rodeo on Big Hat website, FB page and IPRA website and FB page
 - Contestants gets 100 competition points for each event they compete in.
 - Winners at each rodeo receive points as detailed below...All points earned are doubled at the 3 Double point rodeos
- If a tie exists, contestant competing at the most Tour rodeos wins, if a tie still exists, contestant who placed at the most Tour rodeos wins.
 - You must place in a minimum of 1 rodeo to qualify for awards
 - Points are as follows:

1st place: 700 points 2nd place: 600 points 3rd place: 500

points

4th place: 400 points 5th place: 300 points 6th place: 200

points

NOTE: Multiple entry contestants: You will receive 100 competition points for each event you enter. (Example: If you're entered in the TDR and twice in the TR, you get 200 competition points. If you win the TDR and place third in the TR you get the largest one event total point count. In this case you'd get 200 competition points and 700 points for the win so 900 points for that rodeo.) If you're entered in one event and you win you'll get 100 competition points and 700 points for the win=800 total.

Heading & Heeling are considered 2 separate events....so you have to compete in each at 7 rodeos to qualify for awards in both categories.
